

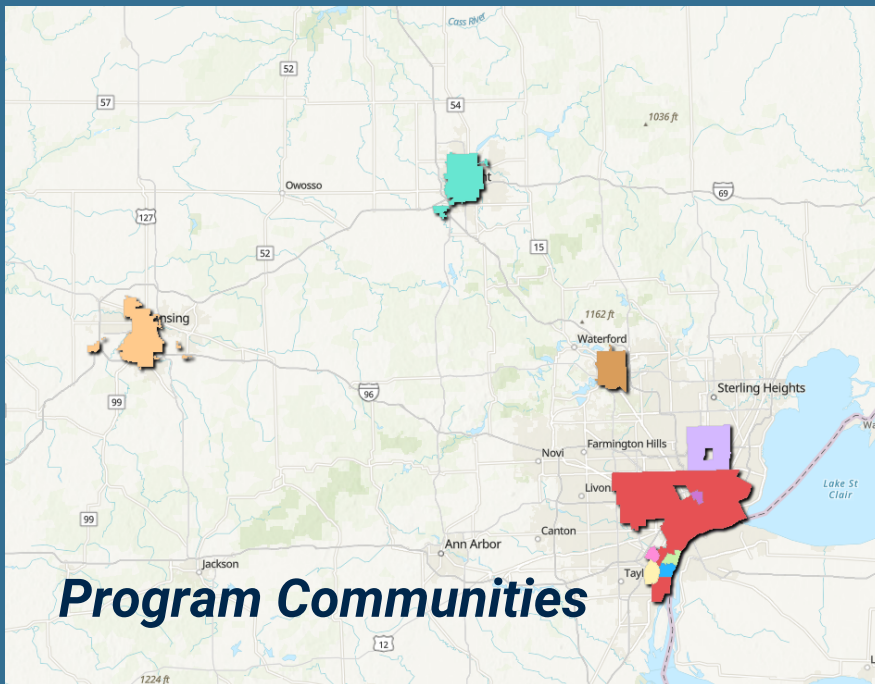
MICHIGAN VEHICLE TECHNOLOGY TRANSITION IMPACT PROJECT

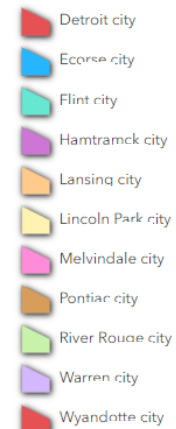
