

RACER TRUST ENVIRONMENTAL PUBLIC UPDATE MEETING

RACER Trust has scheduled a public meeting on Thursday, November 21, to provide an update on its continuing environmental remediation work at the Buick City property in Flint.

The meeting will take place from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the Dome Auditorium, located in the South Building at Flint City Hall, 1101 S. Saginaw Street, near the 7th Street parking lot.

The discussion will be led by Patricia Spitzley, RACER Director of Government Relations/ Deputy Redevelopment Manager; Grant Trigger, RACER Cleanup Manager; and Brendan Mullen, RACER Michigan Cleanup Manager. A brief presentation will be followed by a question-and-answer opportunity.

RACER's environmental activities at Buick City are carried out under the direction of the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE). A representative of EGLE has been invited to participate.

RACER — for Revitalizing Auto Communities Environmental Response — has conducted environmental cleanup and other activities at Buick City under regulatory oversight since 2011.

The purpose of the meeting is to share information and answer questions about RACER's environmental activities.
